

Critical Information Summary: NBN Wireless

About the Service

The NBN Wireless service is a broadband internet service which uses the NBN Fixed Wireless Network to deliver internet connectivity to the Network Boundary Point at your premises.

Minimum Term

Choose from:

- No lock-in contract with \$0 activation fee, or
- 6 month contract with \$0 activation fee (new customers only).

Early Cancellation Fees

- No lock-in contract – none. You can cancel at any time.
- 6 month contract – if you cancel before the period ends, you will need to pay a \$40 break fee.
- Cancelling the NBN Wireless service will also cancel any other iiNet products that are only available with NBN Wireless. Should those products have their own contract, you are liable for their associated break fees.

Hardware Non-Return Fees

- If you withdraw an order from us (before your service is activated) and receive the modem we supplied to you, you will need to pay for the modem unless it is returned to us in good working order within 21 days of withdrawing your order.
- If you cancel your service after it has been activated, any applicable modem payment fees will apply in accordance with the terms and conditions of your chosen service.

- The NBN12 500 plan is 0.012c/MB.
- Total Minimum Charge on no lock-in contract is the \$114.95 modem fee, \$0 modem delivery fee plus one month of plan rental.
- Total Minimum Charge on a 6 month contract is 6 months of plan rental, the \$74.95 modem fee and \$0 modem delivery fee.

Availability

- This service is available in areas serviced by the NBN (Fixed Wireless). Use our coverage checker www.iinet.net.au/internet-products/broadband/nbn/coverage/ to check NBN availability at your address.
- Non-standard installations may incur additional fees. An nbn™ \$300 New Development Charge applies if your premises is identified by nbn™ as being within the site boundary of a new development.

Required Equipment

- An NBN compatible modem that is WiFi enabled to connect with wireless devices. For more information, see here: iihelp.iinet.net.au/node/17106#hardwarelookup
- To be provided a working NBN Phone service you need a standard phone handset (approved for use in Australia) and you must purchase an iiNet modem. If you are an existing customer you may be able to use your existing modem – we will advise you if your modem is compatible during selection of your NBN Wireless plan.
 - An iiNet modem costs \$114.95 on a no lock-in contract (discounted to \$74.95 if you take a 6 month contract or if you are an existing customer) plus \$0 delivery fee.
- Any cabling that is required in your premises beyond the Network Boundary Point is your responsibility. Standard installations are completed without charge to you. Non-standard, additional or subsequent installations may require you to pay additional charges.

NBN Fixed Wireless Speeds

- Typical Evening Speed is subject to change and is measured between 7pm and 11pm. NBN12 & NBN25 indicate the underlying speed tier that your NBN plan is on and represents the maximum possible speed that is available outside the busy period of 7pm-11pm.

- Actual speeds may vary due to many factors including type/source of content being downloaded, hardware and software configuration, the number of users simultaneously using the network and performance of interconnecting infrastructure not operated by iiNet. Addresses with speeds affected by NBN Co wireless network congestion will be notified. Devices connected by WiFi may experience slower speeds than those connected by Ethernet cable. - Where you use an NBN Fixed Wireless Service and your usage falls within certain parameters set by NBN Co, your download or upload speeds may be impacted by NBN Co's enforcement of its fair use policy. This could mean you may, from time to time, experience slower speeds depending on your usage, the time of day and the type of applications you are using.

Excess Usage

- Both uploads and downloads count towards your monthly included data. If you exceed your included data for the month, you are not charged for excess usage. Instead, traffic beyond the included data will be slowed (shaped) to 256/256kbps for NBN12 500. You may purchase additional data if required.
