The iiNet Group (iiNet Ltd, Westnet Pty Ltd, Internode Pty Ltd, AAPT Consumer Division and TransACT Capital Communications Pty Ltd) is currently working to manage the impact to its network that has occurred as a result of extreme weather events in the North East, Midlands, East Coast, Upper Derwent Valley and South East regions of Tasmania on or about Sunday 21 July 2013.

The exemption shall apply from 23 July 2013 to 16 August 2013 inclusive. This date is indicative only; customers should anticipate that some further delays may occur.
