Extreme Weather events impact service in Perth and Greater Perth, Lower West, Central Wheat Belt, Great Southern and South West Districts of Western Australia. iiNet Group reference ID: 2782345

As previously notified on 13 September 2013, the iiNet Group (iiNet Ltd, Westnet Pty Ltd, Internode Pty Ltd, AAPT Consumer Division, TransACT Capital Communications Pty Ltd and Jiva Pty Ltd) is currently working to manage the impact to its network that has occurred as a result of extreme weather events in the Perth and Greater Perth, Lower West, Central Wheat Belt, Great Southern and South West region of Western Australia on or about Saturday 7 September 2013.

Severe thunderstorms have caused notable damage to the network, rendering some services faulty, as referred to in Telstra Wholesales Mass Service Disruption Notification which can be found at http://telstra.com.au/abouttelstra/commitments/mass-service-disruption/. A copy of this notice will also be published in the **West Australian on 8 October 2013.**

The iiNet Group is working closely with suppliers and wholesalers to assess and repair the damage to affected services in a timely manner. Customers in these regions may experience service disruptions and delays to normal connection times and fault restoration. The impact in the affected region has been greater than initially estimated and as a consequence of the continued weather effects, the expected date for resumption of normal service operations has been extended to Friday 1 November 2013.

As these circumstances are outside the iiNet Group's control, iiNet is claiming an exemption under Section 21 of the Telecommunications (Customer Service Guarantee) Standard 2011 from the normal performance standards. The exemption shall apply from 9 September 2013 to 1 November 2013 inclusive. This date is indicative only; customers should anticipate that some further delays may occur.
