

# Customer Service Notice from iiNet Group

## Ongoing Extreme Weather events impact service in East Coast, South East, Western, Upper Derwent Valley and Central Plateau Districts of Tasmania

**iiNet Group reference ID: 3774825**

As previously notified on 20 January 2015 and 10 February 2015, the iiNet Group (iiNet Ltd, Westnet Pty Ltd, AAPT Consumer Division, Internode Pty Ltd, TransACT Capital Communications Pty Ltd, Jiva Pty Ltd and Adam Internet Pty Ltd) is currently working to manage the impact to its network that has occurred as a result of ongoing extreme weather events in the East Coast, South East, Western, Upper Derwent Valley and Central Plateau Districts of Tasmania on or about Tuesday 13 January 2015, continuing to date.

Heavy Rainfall has caused notable damage to the network, rendering some services faulty, as referred to in Telstra Wholesales Mass Service Disruption Notification which can be found at <http://telstra.com.au/abouttelstra/commitments/mass-service-disruption/>. A copy of this notice will also be published in the **Hobart Mercury** on **24 February 2015**.

The iiNet Group is working closely with suppliers and wholesalers to assess and repair the damage to affected services in a timely manner. Customers in these regions may experience service disruptions and delays to normal connection times and fault restoration. The impact in the affected region has been greater than initially estimated and as a consequence of ongoing weather effects, the expected date for resumption of normal service operations has been extended to **8 March 2015**.

As these circumstances are outside the iiNet Group's control, iiNet is claiming an exemption under Section 21 of the Telecommunications (Customer Service Guarantee) Standard 2011 from the normal performance standards. The exemption shall apply from **14 January 2015 to 8 March 2015** inclusive. This date is indicative only; customers should anticipate that some further delays may occur.
