

Customer Service Notice from iiNet Group



(iiNet Ltd, Westnet Pty Ltd, Internode Pty Ltd,
TransACT Capital Communications Pty Ltd, Adam Internet Pty Ltd).

Severe Weather events impact service in Sunshine Coast and part of the Wide Bay and Burnett District of Queensland.

iiNet Group reference ID: 4571847

As previously notified on **5 February 2016**, the iiNet Group (iiNet Ltd, Westnet Pty Ltd, Internode Pty Ltd, TransACT Capital Communications Pty Ltd and Adam Internet Pty Ltd) is currently working to manage the impact to its network that has occurred as a result of a series of severe weather events in the Sunshine Coast and part of the Wide Bay and Burnett District of Queensland on or about Friday 29 January 2016 through to Saturday 30 January 2016.

The severe weather events have caused notable damage to the network, rendering some services faulty, as referred to in Telstra Wholesales Mass Service Disruption Notification which can be found at <http://telstra.com.au/abouttelstra/commitments/mass-service-disruption/>. A copy of this notice will also be published in the **Brisbane Courier Mail** on **08 March 2016**.

The iiNet Group is working closely with suppliers and wholesalers to assess and repair the damage to affected services in a timely manner. Customers in these regions may experience service disruptions and delays to normal connection times and fault restoration. The impact in the affected region has been greater than initially estimated and as a consequence of the continued weather effects, the expected date for resumption of normal service operations has been extended to **20 March 2016**.

As these circumstances are outside the iiNet Group's control, iiNet is claiming an exemption under Section 21 of the Telecommunications (Customer Service Guarantee) Standard 2011 from the normal performance standards. The exemption shall apply from **1 February 2016 to 20 March 2016** inclusive. This date is indicative only; customers should anticipate that some further delays may occur.
