5 October 2009 – iiNet Managing Director, Michael Malone has welcomed tomorrow’s start of the Federal Court case where the company will vigorously defend allegations that it encouraged and authorised customers to share and download films in breach of copyright laws.

Mr Malone said he was very confident of iiNet’s defence and position.

“iiNet has never in any way supported or encouraged breaches of the law, including infringement of the Copyright Act” Mr Malone said.

“We do not, and never have supported, encouraged or authorised illegal sharing or downloading of files in breach of copyright laws.

“I am very confident” that we will be vindicated and these allegations will be dismissed as unfounded, untrue and unproven.”

“I am proud of iiNet’s long and strong record of being a good corporate citizen and an even better ‘copyright citizen’.”

“iiNet has been an industry leader and innovator in encouraging customers to access licensed and legally available copyright content through our Freezone.

“I welcome the commencement of the Court proceedings and look forward to clearing our name”.

The Federal Court hearings commence in Sydney on Tuesday 6 October.
